## 2023 Outstanding Student Achievement Awards

The Oregon Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics recognizes up to two (2) Oregon Academy student members annually.

### Award purpose:

To recognize emerging leadership potential in the field of dietetics through academic success and achievements in campus and dietetic-related professional organization activities, work (paid and/or volunteer) experience, and planned professional goals.

### Criteria:

- Must be an Oregon Academy student member, as of December 31st of the year prior to the award being given (i.e., for the 2022 awards, students must be members as of 12/31/21)
- Can be an incoming and graduating senior, graduate student or intern

### Award categories:

- (1) Outstanding Undergraduate Student
- (1) Outstanding Intern and/or Postgraduate program participant

### Applications and timeline:

- Nominee submissions due January 31, 2023. (Materials sent to [oand@quidnunc.net](mailto:oand@quidnunc.net)).
  - Application will include:
    - ✓ [An online application](#) (including volunteer and work experience)
    - ✓ An unofficial transcript
    - ✓ A resume
    - ✓ A candidate essay summarizing current and future professional goals, including planned professional leadership (no more than 500 words)
- Applicant review – February 1 – 7, 2023
- Award recipients named by February 25, 2023

- Academy recognition (via *The Journal of the Academy Nutrition and Dietetics*)
